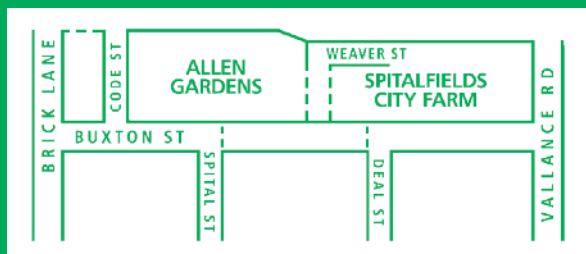

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Show is open to all those who wish to enter.

Exhibits of flowers, fruit and vegetables must have been grown by the exhibitors with the exception of classes 131, 132, 175, 176 & 177.

Exhibits in classes 128, 129, and 130 must have been cultivated by the exhibitor for at least two months prior to the show.

Exhibits in Preserves, Fruit & Flower Drinks, Cookery, Handicrafts, Children's Section and Sweets must have been made by the exhibitor.

All entry forms should be sent in by Monday 7 September 2009. (Late entries will be accepted up to 10am on the day but please try to enter beforehand)

It is free to enter the Show. No fee is charged.

No more than 3 exhibits per person per class.

Children may enter any class in addition to their own Division.

All exhibits must be brought to the Marquee on Allen Gardens at 9am on Sunday 13 September and arranged by 11am. No entries will be accepted after 10am.

All exhibitors must provide their own plates, vases, containers, and water.

All entries must be clearly labelled with official Show Labels provided on the day.

All exhibitors must retire from the exhibition before the Judges proceed to make their awards.

Judging of exhibits will take place at 11am prompt. The Judges' decision is final.

Judging of pets will take place at 1pm and 2pm.

Trophies, Rosettes and Certificates will be awarded at the discretion of the Judges.

Exhibitors will be judged:
1st (5 points), 2nd (3 points), 3rd (2 points), Highly Commended (1 point) in each Class.

The Show will open at 12noon.

Exhibits must not be removed before 4pm. Any exhibits left will be auctioned at 4.15pm after the prizes have been awarded.

Prize giving will take place at 4pm. All First Prize winners receive a rosette. **The Champions Cup** will be given to the adult exhibitor gaining the highest number of points, **The Group Champions Cup** will be given to the group gaining the highest number of points and the **Junior Champions Cup** will be given to the child exhibitor gaining the most points.
